1. Must be currently enrolled at UCSC with a minimum of 12 units.
2. Must be an EOP student.
3. Must be in financial hardship and have exhausted all forms of financial aid (including forms of loans, work-study, etc).
4. All books awarded in prior quarters must be turned in to be considered for Spring 2013
5. Must utilize an EOP service in the concurrent quarter, (ie meet with an EOP counselor, PAL, or Pre Grad)

- If DACA eligible, utilize the institutional work-study option
- Apply to be an Residential Assistant (covers your cost of housing and meal plan)
- Apply for the Chancellor's Undergraduate Internship Program CUIP Internship (\$8200 stipend)
- Living off-campus may be cheaper; but if not an option, choose the cheapest room available on-campus; with the reduced meal plan; take advantage of food pantries to make up the difference
- Cook, don't eat out too often, you need to stretch every dollar
- Apply for private scholarships-- on-going
